What is Paintball all about?

In less than a decade, the sport of paintball has become recognised as one of the world's most exciting sports. Paintball is played in over forty countries by millions of men and women of all ages and lifestyles. Whether homemakers or high-school students, professionals or retirees, all paintball players share in common a love for adventure and a strong competitive spirit.

Paintball is a combination of childhood "tag" and "hide and seek", but is much more challenging and sophisticated. Although there are many different game formats, typically a group of players will divide into two teams to play "Capture the Flag".

The number of players on each team can vary from four to five to as many as 500 a side, limited only by the size of the playing field. AQPS fields normally cater for teams around 15-20 per side.

The objective of the game is to go out and capture the other team's flag while protecting your own. While you are trying to capture a flag, you also try to eliminate opposing players by tagging them with a paintball expelled by a special Co2 gas-powered paintgun.

Games usually have a time limit of 15 to 20 minutes, depending on the size of the field and the number of players. Between games, players take a break to check their equipment, recount the thrills of victory and the usually funny agonies of defeat. Win or lose, everyone has a good time and there's always the next game waiting for you.

Paintguns come in a variety of shapes and styles, powered by refillable 12oz CO2 cylinders that supply hundreds of shots. A paintgun has a pump or semi automatic action. Paintguns range from simple to sophisticated, but what they all share in common is the limitation on their power and range. Even at maximum elevation a paintgun won't hit hard enough to cause injury as long as the proper safety procedures are followed.

Referees on the fields start and stop games, enforce the rules of fair play, and control the sport's safety. Reputable fields have a large staff of referees and run several games at the same time on different areas of their property coordinated by two-way radio. Paintball is also played in arenas for spectator enjoyment.

Paintball is a sport played by people from all professions and life styles. It is a sport where men and women compete equally, and where age is not dominated by youth. Physical strength and size are not as important as intelligence and determination.

Like a game of chess, being able to think quickly and decisively is what marked you a star. Paintball is a character building sport. Players learn the importance of team-work and gain self-confidence while developing leadership abilities.

Paintball is an exciting sport. Above all Paintball is fun! It's a chance to relax from your everyday responsibilities and rekindle your spirit of adventure.

Once the adrenalin starts pumping you can't help but love the thrill of the game!

Players must start with a minimum of 300 paintballs if you shoot 400 or more paintballs the rate drops to \$18 per 100

\$60 minimum per player and your on field with 300 paintballs, all equipment and lunch!

NOW THAT IS "EASY RATES"

Players must lodge a deposit of \$30pp prior to the day of play. On the day of play each player in attendance will have a credit of \$30 to start.

Players are welcome to book in individually.

On weekends you may book from 1-150 players! During the week we can open our fields for groups of 30 or more players. Groups of 30 or more players may also play separately. As bookings are subject to availability be sure to book early to avoid disappointment. We're open 7.30am to 4.00pm with games running between 8.30am and 3.30pm.

Players must register between 7.30am and 8.30am on the day of play unless otherwise arranged.

BOOKING DEPOSITS

Having confirmed a day and then placed a booking with Adventure Quest Paintball Skirmish, next you must lodge a deposit of \$30.00 per person prior to your intended play date. The \$30.00 deposit is deducted from the cost of the package chosen by attending players on the date of your event. (STD rates only)

Deposits are due at the time of making your booking, however for large group bookings and / or for bookings made well in advance we will be flexible in working with you to allow sufficient opportunity to pay your deposit. Registration will take place at the field, where you will receive your hire equipment and undergo a safety briefing prior to play. Group / team numbers are at the discretion of AQPS. Separate groups are usually around 30 players.

What to bring

Photograph identification – **NO EXCEPTIONS**- (e.g. birth card, driver licence, proof of age card, passport, student identification etc.). This also applies to any person aged 16 to 18 who has an authority from their parent / legal guardian to play paintball. The importance of bringing this identification cannot be stressed enough. Please pass this information on to all persons in your group, as refusal of entry to our playing fields for any of your group may be embarrassing for you and disappointing for the person concerned.

Recommended clothing would be a light tracksuit or shorts and T-shirt to wear under overalls. Strong footwear preferably with ankle support; we recommend using hiking boots, GP's etc. as running / casual shoes, whilst being comfortable do not provide sufficient support in bush / rough terrain situations. A baseball cap or similar and gloves may also be beneficial. For your convenience men's groin guards and fingerless camouflage gloves may also be purchased at our fields.

Minimum age to play paintball at Adventure Quest Paintball Skirmish is 16, there are no exceptions. All players over 16 years of age but under 18 years of age at the date of the event may play provided the conditions of the attached authority are met and such authority is both legible and correctly completed. The authority **MUST** be produced on the day.

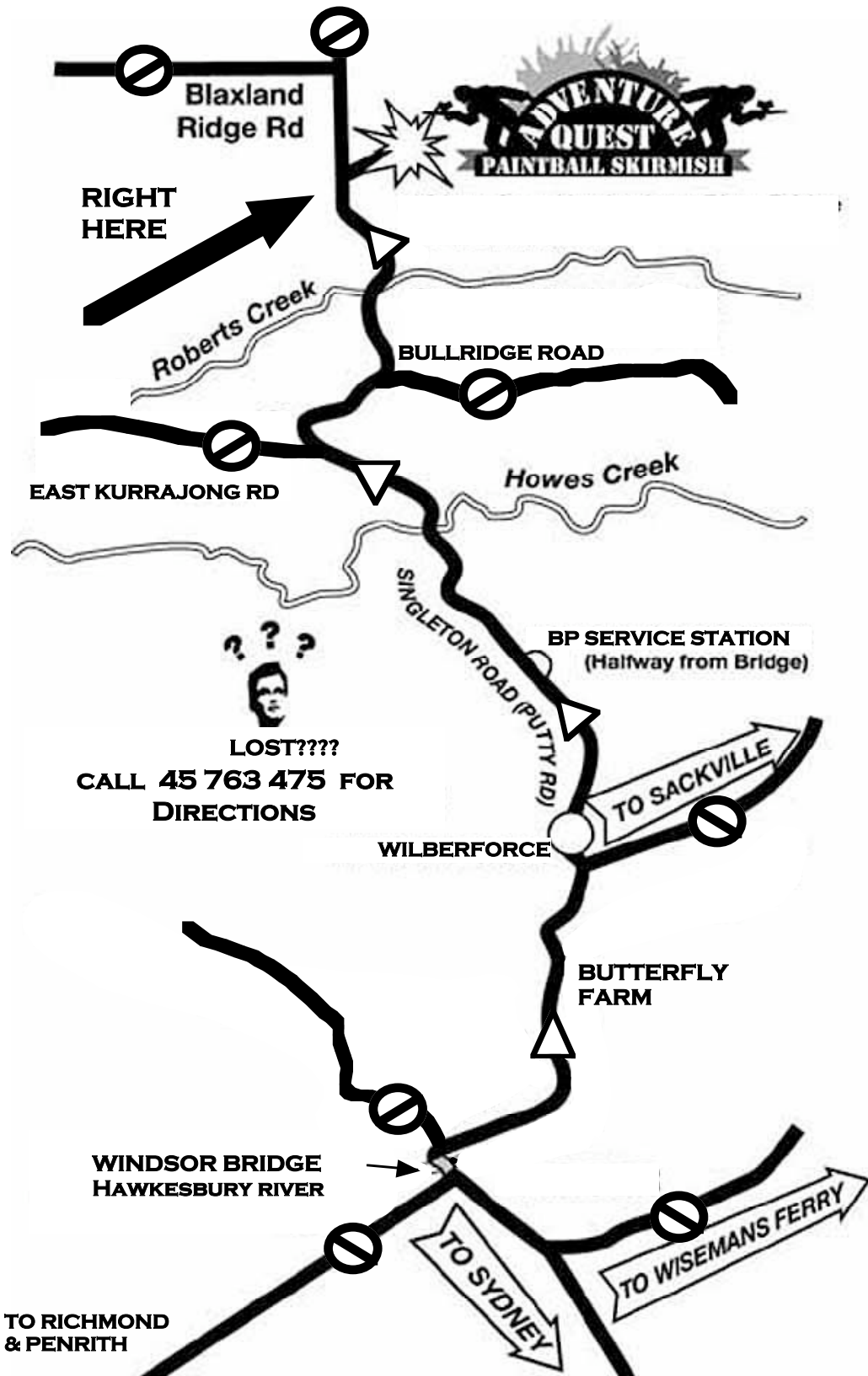
- * I am aware that participation in Paintball Skirmish games may be hazardous and result in injury.

Follow Windsor Road north to Windsor and proceed directly ahead through the traffic lights near the Police Station (Macquarie Street). You are on Bridge Street, Windsor. If you reach the Colo River you have gone too far and need to turn around. The trip from Windsor to AQPS will take approximately 15 to 18 minutes.
